

NOTES ON TODAY'S TOPIC.

John 6:25-58

JC Soundbites: : I am the living bread from heaven

1. GET A REAL LIFE!

Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. (John 6:27)

- a) I want

- b) I'll work 'till I drop

- c) Work for food that endures to eternal life

2. CHRIST ALONE CAN GIVE REAL LIFE

Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty." (John 6:35)

- a) He is the I AM

- b) He is from heaven

- c) He is the life giver

3. NEVER FORGET THE COST OF YOUR REAL LIFE

Jesus said to them, "I tell you the truth, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you." (John 6:53)

- a) The cost was colossal

- b) We must identify with our Lord and his death for us

- c) We are to feed on Him
